The emphasis is on the development of a warm and trusting relationship between parents, children, and the Red Cross instructor. This relationship serves as the basis for learning.

Q. Can a non-member sign-up for private lessons?

A. Yes, best times are fall through winter, winter through spring, and spring to the end of June.

Q. How do I know if private lessons are what I want?

A. You're welcome to come in to observe a class. I recommend you bring your child in also, to get familiar with the new environment. Sometimes it's overwhelming for a child to be introduced to a swim class, if they have never been to the pool, bring your suit and enjoy observing the classes. This will help you and your child before the first swim lesson begins. Preparation is your best tool.
