

## **FLEX LEAGUE**

### **INFORMATION AND RULES**

Book 1½ hours of court time. Ten minute warm up including serves; regular scoring. If you book only 1 hour of court time, use no-ad scoring. Play 2 out of 3 sets in either case. Check court times, prices vary at different times.

If the match is not finished when the court time ends, count total games won to determine the winner.

Each player gets 1 point each for playing, 1 point for each set won and 1 point for winning the match.

The top 1 or 2 players at the end of the time period will move up to the next flight. The bottom 1 or 2 players will move down to lower flight (depending on the size of flight). The winner of a flight wins a free ½ hour private tennis lesson!

Please note that provisions will be made for new players entering the league. Players who wish not to continue in the next session **MUST** let Lorie (Wayland) or Holly (Natick) know. If we do not hear from you, your name will automatically be included in next roster.

Where players have the same point total at the end of the time period, the winner of their head to head play is then ranked higher.

Please make sure you play all of your matches, it will hinder the league if you don't. You are responsible for reserving a court for your league match. Feel free to use either club's courts. Natick: 508-653-4606; Wayland: 508-358-7355. Note: a 24-hour cancellation applies. **BOTH** players are responsible for calling their opponent and setting up the match. If you have not heard back from your opponent in 24 hours, please contact them again! **DO NOT WAIT!**

It is essential that players play opponents in the order assigned. If your opponent is unavailable in the assigned week, please play the match during the make up week. Each player who completes all of his/her matches in each flight, wins his/her portion of 1 ½ hours of court time.

**Both players bring 1 can of new balls – the winner takes home the unopened can!**

Fill out a green score card, located at the front desk of both clubs, and leave for either Holly (Natick) or Lorie (Wayland). **GOOD LUCK & HAVE FUN!**
