Welcome to Longfellow Arts Camp!

Our camp runs from July 2 through August 24, 2012. Enrollment is on a pre-paid basis in weekly sessions. We hope this brochure is helpful in explaining the basic features of our camp. Longfellow Arts Camp welcomes children ranging from those entering kindergarten (Fall '12) through 7th graders (Fall '12). Enrollment is limited and children are assigned to one of two groups based on their age.

Camp Hours & Fees

Longfellow Arts Camp has 8, 1-week sessions. Camp tuition is \$390/week by 4/1/12 (\$415 after 4/1/12) and \$315 for the week of July 2 - 6 by 4/1/12 (\$335 after 4/1/12). Camp hours are Monday - Friday, 9 a.m. - 4 p.m. Dropoff is 8:50 - 9:00 a.m. and pickup is 4:00 - 4:10 p.m. Counselors will escort children to and from their parent's/guardian's cars.

Extended Day

Extended care is available from 7:30 a.m. - 6:00 p.m. (breakfast is served from 8:00 - 8:30 a.m.) with a camper:counselor ratio of 8:1. Extended care activities may include basketball, wiffle ball, dodge ball, arts and crafts, quiet board games, and outdoor play. Cost is \$13 per hour and quantity discounts are available.
