Team Tennis for Kids

The Longfellow Club is now offering team tennis for boys and girls, ages 8 to 13, of any level! From March 30 until May 29, kids can play on either a mixed-doubles team, a doubles team for boys or girls, or singles. Players will hit balls that are color-specific to their level -- either orange for beginner/intermediate 8 to 10 year olds, green for advanced 8 to 10 year olds, or yellow for 10 to 12 year olds. They'll not only learn how to play competitive tennis, but they will also gain valuable lessons, including mental toughness, sportsmanship, and how to be a team player.
